Aim	To engage Maltese youths in cultural participation
Type of Action	Providing financial assistance to individuals participating in cultural events and disciplines.
Target Audience	Maltese young people between the ages of 15 and 35
	years.
Time Period	4 st January 2017 – 31 st December 2017, or until the fund
	is fully taken up
Available Funds	€2,000



Terms and Conditions

For the purposes of the document:

KNŻ shall signify the Kunsill Nazzjonali taż-Żgħażagħ / Malta National Youth Council.

The board shall signify the three members managing the fund as per clause 2.1.

The applicant shall signify any Maltese citizen between the ages of 15 and 35 who puts forward a funding request application.

Article 1 - The KNŻ Youth Cultural Fund

- 1.1 The fund shall consist of €2,000 initiated and administered by the KNŻ.
- 1.2The deadline of application submission is the 31st of December 2017.
- 1.3 Cultural activities, as per clause 3.2, shall be eligible if they occurred or have started during the specified time period.

Article 2 - The Board

- 2.1 The board shall consist of 3 members: the KNŻ Financial Officer, KNŻ President and an individual nominated and elected by the KNŻ Member Organisations during the Organisations' Committee. This individual is not to be a member of the same Executive Board and is to be involved in youth and cultural activities.
- 2.2The board shall base all of its decisions on the following Rules and Regulations.
- 2.3The decision regarding eligibility of a submitted application requires a simple majority from the board members.
- 2.4The subsidy cannot be granted if a simple majority during a Board meeting is not reached.
- 2.5The decision taken by the board is final and no appeal can be made, save in cases of illegality.
- 2.6The board is obliged to give the reasons of inegibility should the Board reject the eligibility of an application.





Article 3 – Eligibility for awarding of grants

- 3.1 The applicant should be a Maltese citizen as per the Laws of Malta and should be between the ages of 15 and 35 years at the time of application.
- 3.2 Cultural activities include, but are not limited to:
 - 3.2.1 Membership or tutorship fee for drama, music, art, dancing, singing lessons/sessions
 - 3.2.2 Entrance fees to cultural shows, musicals, plays and concerts whenever:
 - 3.2.2.1Food and drinks are not included in the price
 - 3.2.2.2 The applicant opts for the cheapest tickets available
 - 3.2.3 Visits to museums, cultural buildings and exhibitions
 - 3.2.4 Entrance fees to libraries and private archives
 - 3.2.4 Purchase of any musical instruments.
 - 3.2.5 Any other events or goods which the board might deem eligible.
- 3.3The application will not be eligible should it be submitted after the 31st of December 2017 or once the fund balance of €2,000 is given in grants.

Article 4 - The Grant

- 4.1 The grant for each eligible applicant is to cover 50% of the eligible fees or a maximum of €100.
- 4.2 The applicant can only apply once during the timeframe of the fund.
- 4.3 An application can contain more than one fee as per clause 3.2.
- 4.4 The grant is to be less than the amounts stated in 4.1 should the fund balance be less than the eligible amount.





Article 5 - Application process

- 5.1 The applicant must present:
 - 5.1.1 In the case of performing arts, etc.: A fiscal receipt together with the fund application having Part 1 completed by the applicant and part 2 by the management/tutor of the performing art in question.
 - 5.1.2 In the case of Cultural Events: The ticket/s of the event/s mentioned in clauses 3.2.2 and 3.2.3 and the fund application having part 1 completed by the applicant.
- 5.2The fund application can be downloaded from the KNŻ website and social-sites or asked for by sending an email to culturefund@knz.org.mt.
- 5.3The application, together with the hard copy of evidence mentioned in clause 5.1, is to be addressed and sent to:

- 5.4The Board shall reimburse the applicant once the application is approved as per the clauses of this document.

Creative Communities

Creative Communities is a fund for community-led creative and artistic activities, primarily addressing local communities. Its aim is to engage these groups in creativity and arts-driven projects and thereby increase their level of integration and engagement in society. The potential of art and creativity in fostering social and cultural change and regeneration has been shown and proven in a number of including those characterised by socially-challenaina environments, poverty, and exclusion. This understanding is the basis for the President's Award for Creativity. The initiative supports and awards projects submitted by state entities, education institutions, not-for-profit (voluntary) organisations, and enterprises that address the needs of disadvantaged groups by means of art and creativity.
